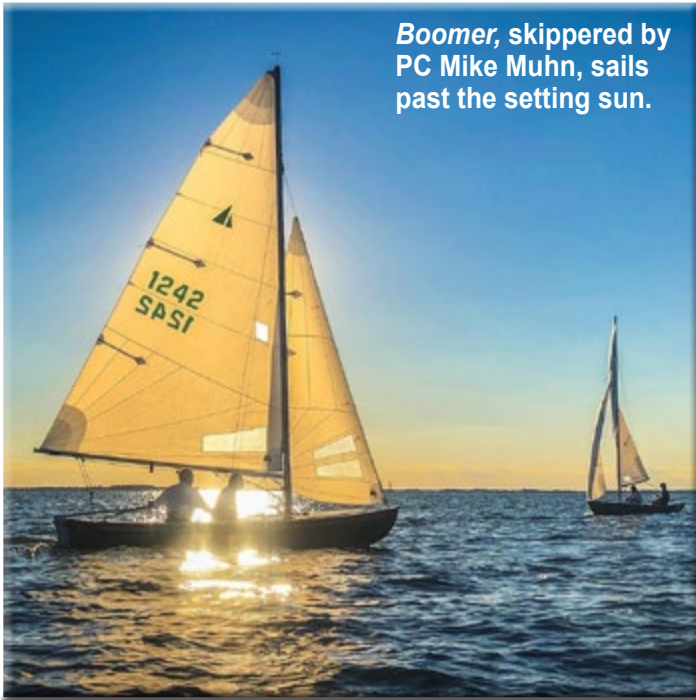
Thanks everyone for your help during the regatta, as it would not have been a success without everyone pitching in.

Moving forward - Reminder of what we need to do to protect our club, our reputation, and our mission...Sailing. I want to remind everyone of what we need to do moving forward to ensure we can continue to operate in a manner to support our mission as well as be safe. Please consider the bullets below as adhering to these simple rules will protect our ability to provide a fun and opportunity-rich club.

- As per Liquor Control Board orders, the Dairy Bar will be open with last call at 10pm. Beverages (within the liquor premises) need to be finished by 11pm. Carryout beverages need to be purchased by 10pm and remain unopened within the liquor premises until taken outside the liquor premises for enjoyment.

- Masks are required when moving about inside the clubhouse; and please observe of the 6ft separation requirement.

- We will likely keep the Dairy Bar window inside the club closed to ensure we operate within the rules of the State and Liquor Control Board.

- Outdoors, very similar. Masks are requested when mingling around, and when seated, obviously they can be removed to facilitate the consumption of the stellar beer selections we have, as well as cocktails and food.

- Picnic tables will be moved out into the grass for larger events to ensure we adhere to 6 feet of separation, supplemented by other seating on the patio.

The docks in the dry storage gravel area are taped off.

We will keep everyone informed as to the solution. You may tie your boat up along the wall adjacent to the ramp, but please remember to only tie off to the 4x4 posts.

Sadler Basin Committee PC Steve Jackson Fall equinox is just a few weeks away. This summer went fast and Sadler Basin Committee is gearing up for the off season.

Winter dock prep - The water supply in the basin will probably be shut off the first full week in October. Pipes will be blown out, water drained and anti freeze installed. Fire extinguishers will be removed and stored inside for the winter and other seasonal fixtures will be winterized.

A dock - We are looking at replacing the entire wood deck of “A” dock, probably starting mid to late October. If you will be in the marina, please don't moor on “A” dock. This project should take 10 to 14 days, depending on weather and wood material availability.

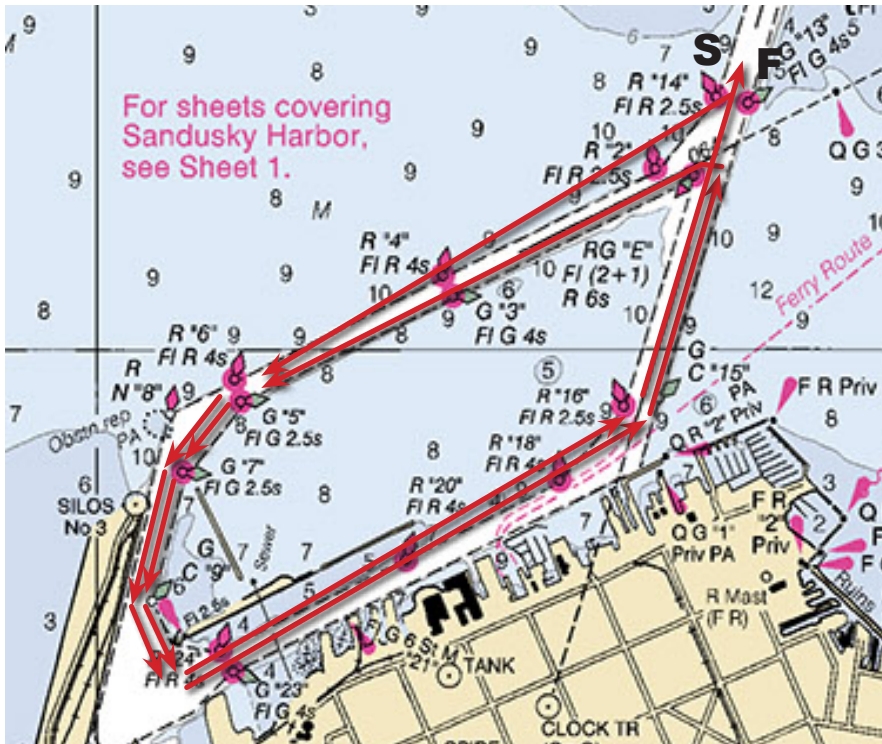

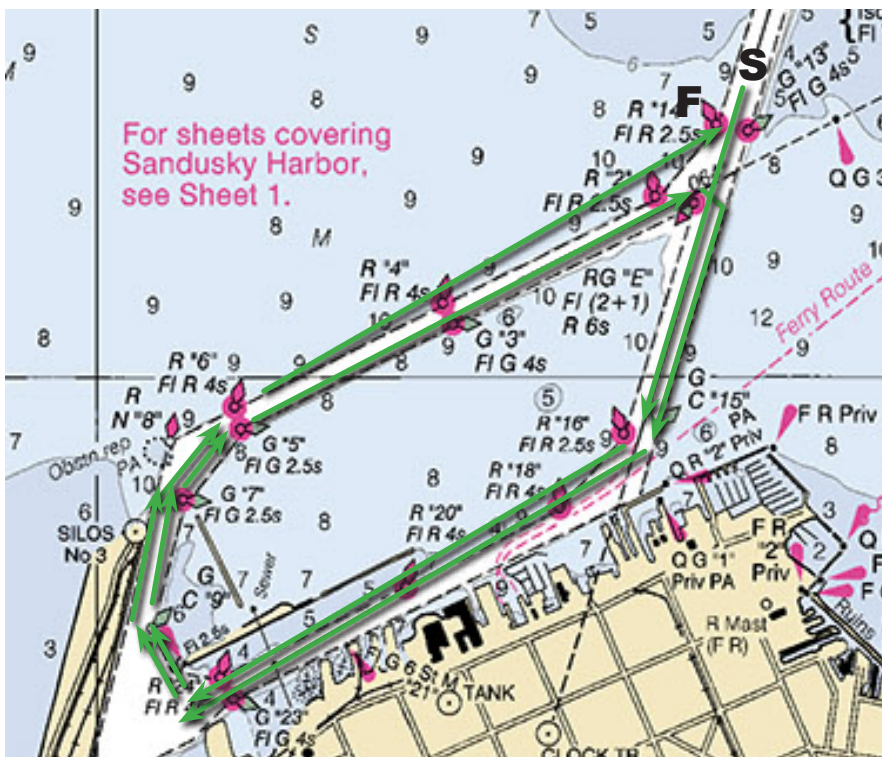
