

University of Toledo Sailing Team bested 51 other collegiate sailing teams to win the prestigious Intercollegiate Offshore Regatta and to receive the Paul Hoffman Perpetual Trophy as the overall winning team of the regatta. The Intercollegiate Offshore Regatta is one of the largest collegiate sailing events in the country and boasts an entry list of the Who's Who of collegiate sailing.

Teams from the United States, Canada and France included the US Naval Academy, The Ohio State University, Michigan, Michigan State University, College of Charleston, US Coast Guard Academy, Queen's University, and Arts et Metiers Paris Tech to name only a few.

The UT team consisted of eight students (a few of whom are freshly out of our I-LYA Junior Sailing program); team members were: Garrett Altenberger, Drew Blackburn (SSC), Evon DePrey, Deborah Dollard, Luke Gossman, Hans Guentert, Andrew Logan and Colin Mackay. The UT Sailing Team was sailing for the first time ever in this event. They competed in the PHRF Division scoring 1, 1, 1, 2 and 2 in five races held over two days, winning their class and being awarded the First Overall Team Trophy.

As a result of their overall victory, the team has been chosen to participate in the "crew exchange" program between the Intercollegiate Offshore Regatta and the EDHEC Sailing Cup being held April 25 to May 2, 2015 in Les Sables-D'Olonne, France. The EDHEC Sailing Cup is the largest student offshore regatta in the world.
